# Paradigm Shift in Governance & Creating Inclusive Infrastructure



As India is poised to rise steadily on the path of becoming a global our actions hold tremendous possibilities both for our people and the world in general. Infrastructure is a key driver for the Indian economy. The quality of a nation's infrastructure is a critical index of its economic vitality. 

While a dialect is unstructured and usually does not follow a grammar, a language is well structured and must have a rule book or grammar without any exception. Language and communication skill starts from first year of learning i.e. from kindergarten or nursery to higher studies. However, for specialized studies in Languages, you need to learn an advance set of grammar and vocabulary as compared to those used in common communication. October 13, 2021 for multi-modal connectivity and development of holistic Infrastructure. The Prime Minister said, "It will help India realize it's dream of becoming the business capital of the world."

The PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan is based on the following six pillars:-

- Comprehensiveness: It will include all the existing and planned initiatives of various ministries and departments within one centralised portal. Each and every department will now have visibility of each other's activities providing critical data while planning and executing projects in a comprehensive manner.
- Prioritisation: Different departments will be able to prioritise their projects through cross-sectoral interactions.
- Optimisation: The National Master Plan will assist different ministries in planning for projects after identification of critical gaps. For transportation of goods from one place to another, the plan will help in selecting the most optimum route in terms of time and cost.
- Synchronisation: Individual ministries and departments often work in silos. There is a lack of coordination in planning and implementation of the project, resulting in delays. PM Gati Shakti will help in synchronising activities of each department, as well as of different layers of governance, in a holistic manner by ensuring coordination of work between them.
- Analytical: The plan will provide entire data at one place with GIS-based spatial planning and analytical tools having over 200 layers, enabling better visibility to the executing agency.
- Dynamic: All ministries and departments will now be able to visualise, review and monitor the progress of cross-sectoral projects, through the GIS platform, as satellite imagery will give onground progress periodically, and progress of the projects will be updated on a regular basis on the portal. It will help in identifying vital interventions for enhancing and updating the Master Plan.

The PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP) is the third big step and a long impending reform in the direction of infrastructure development in India after the National Infrastructure Pipeline, and the National Monetization Pipeline. Gati Shakti is a campaign to lend more speed (Gati) and power (Shakti) to projects by connecting all concerned departments on one platform. This way, infrastructure schemes of various ministries and state govern-

ments will be designed and executed with a common vision.

The Government of India has identified 81 high-impact projects across multiple infrastructure ministries. The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways is responsible for half of the 81 high-impact projects listed, followed by others. National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation's (NICDC) major industrial corridors, key expressways and highways, including the 1,257-kilometer Amritsar-Jamnagar expressway, 1,350kilometer Delhi-Mumbai expressway, and 210-kilometer Delhi-Saharanpur-Dehradun expressway, as well as the world's largest broadband project BharatNet, will be among the government's priority projects.

Furthermore, focus is on providing assistance and training to states and ministries so that they can use Gati Shakti. A network planning group, made up of officials from multiple ministries, has been established to guarantee that projects are planned in accordance with the master plan. More than 400 data layers with information regarding forest land and available industrial estate are available in the Gati Shakti National Master Plan. As a result, project alignment and other types of permissions will be feasible right at the DPR stage.

The Gati Shakti Master Plan will use geo-mapping and real-time data in one centralised portal to ensure that key departments and states have visibility over major projects being planned, especially the ones which have multi-sectoral and multi-regional reach. Sixteen Central Government departments, including Railways, Roads and Highways, Petroleum and Gas, Power, Telecom, Shipping, Aviation and others will be a part of this initiative.

Each and every department will now have visibility of each other's activities providing critical data while planning and execution of projects in a comprehensive manner. Through this, different departments will be able to prioritise their projects through cross-sectoral interactions. It is apparent that most of the mega projects under the Rs 110 lakh crore National Infrastructure Pipeline will be monitored under Gati Shakti.

Gati Shakti will incorporate infrastructure schemes of various Union Ministries and state governments - Bharatmala Pariyojana, Sagarmala, UDAN, inland waterways, dry/land ports, etc. The plan will also ensure quick completion of works with cost efficiency. The idea is to get all relevant stakeholders aligned for creating the right size

infrastructure at a suitable location expeditiously.

What is Envisaged under Gati Shakti?

- The plan includes 11 industrial corridors, achieving Rs 1.7 lakh crore turnover in defence production and having 38 electronics manufacturing clusters and 109 pharma clusters by 2024-25.
- The National Master Plan fixes targets up to 2024-25 for all infrastructure ministries. For the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, the target is to have national highways of two lakh km, completion of four- or six-lane national highways of 5,590 km along coastal areas and all state capitals in the North-East to be connected with four-lane national highways or two two-lane national highways.
- For the Railways, the target by 2024-25 is to handle cargo of 1,600 million tonne from 1,210 million tonne in 2020, decongesting 51 percent of the Railway network by completing additional lines and implementation of two Dedicated Freight Corridors (DFCs)
- In Civil Aviation, the target is to double the existing aviation footprint to have a total of 220 airports, heliports and water aerodromes by 2025 which will mean building additional 109 such facilities by then. In Shipping, the target by 2024-25 is to have total cargo capacity to be handled at the ports at 1,759 million tpa from 1,282 million tpa in 2020.
- The gas pipeline network in the country is aimed to be doubled to 34,500 km by 2024-25 by building an additional 17,000 km long trunk pipeline connecting major demand and supply centres for industries, as per the plan. In Power Lines, total transmission network by 2024-25 is targeted to be 4.52 lakh circuit km and renewable energy capacity will be increased to 225 GW from 87.7 GW presently.

PM Gati Shakti is a transformative approach for economic growth and sustainable development and driven by the following seven engines:-

- 1. Railways
- 2. Roads
- Ports
- 4. Waterways
- Airports
- Mass Transport

All 7 engines will pull forward the economy in unison. These engines are supported by the complementary roles of Energy Transmission, IT Communication, Bulk Water & Sewerage, and Social Infrastructure. The approach is powered by Clean Energy and Sabka Prayas - the efforts of the Central Government, the state governments, and the private sector together - leading to huge job and

entrepreneurial opportunities for all, especially the youth. The focus will be on planning, financing including through innovative ways, use of technology and speedier implementation.

To conclude, the Gati Shakti programme marks a paradigm shift in decision making to break the silos of departmentalism. PM Gati Shakti will address past issues through institutionalizing holistic planning for stakeholders for major infrastructure projects. Instead of planning & designing separately in silos, infra projects are now expected to be designed and executed with a Economic common vision. Zones like textile clusters, pharmaceutical clusters, defence electronic parks. corridors. industrial corridors. fishing clusters, agri zones will also be covered to improve connectivity and make Indian businesses more competitive.

In this plan, all the existing and proposed economic zones have been mapped along with the multi-modal connectivity infrastructure in a single platform. Individual projects of different Ministries would examined and sanctioned in future within the parameters of the overall Plan, leading to synchronisation of efforts. Gati Shakti will bring synergy to create a world class, seamless multi-modal transport network in India. The National Master Plan will employ modern technology and the latest IT tools for coordinated planning of infrastructure. A GIS-based Enterprise Resource Planning system with 200+ layers for evidencebased decision-making is one example. The use of satellite imagery for monitoring is another. Digitization will play a big role in ensuring timely clearances and flagging potential issues, and in-project monitoring as well.

Gati Shakti plan will give a new direction to the development of modern infrastructure through planning, implementation and monitoring, besides cutting down on time and cost overruns of projects. Increased investment in infrastructure would not only create demand in the economy

but also it would make growth sustainable, equitable, and inclusive and create huge employment opportunities. Due to the multiplier effect, one rupee spent on infrastructure ends up as Rs. 2.5 in the economy. If the multiplier effect of infrastructure investments on Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is to be maximized within a short time frame. it is critical that specific infrastructure projects which form part of critical trade routes, both internal and external, be prioritized.

The wide gap between macro planning and micro implementation, problems of lack of coordination, lack of advance information, and thinking and working in silos are leading to hampered construction and wastage of budget, therefore the Gati Shakti National Master Plan will address these issues and working on the basis of the master plan will lead to optimum utilization of resources.

India has a high logistics cost of around 13 percent of GDP, because of unplanned development which had left ports without rail lines, manufacturing hinterland without access to coasts. and farmers without recourse to markets. As a result, the cost of production goes up and India's export competitiveness comes down, while food inflation rises. Gati Shakti plan will fill these and also leverage technology extensively, including spatial planning tools with ISRO imagery developed by Bhaskaracharya National Institute for Space Applications and Geoinformatics.

The fundamental goal of grassroot level development is to create employment, a level of connectivity where all villages have roads, all house-holds have bank accounts, 100% of beneficiaries have an Ayushman Bharat card, and all eligible people have a gas connection via the Ujjwala scheme.

#### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES ...

As we all know, knowledge cannot be transmitted or communicated without a language, so acquiring language skills is the first aim of education in any society. Even the hearing and speech impaired used special set of language tools in the process of learning and studying. The Quad is a strategic group comprising four nations-India, United States of America, Australia and Japan. 





Under the initiative 'Tharagaigal Kaivinai Porutkal Virpanai Angadi' women's Self-Help Groups stores and kiosks have been opened in Thanjavur. Because of this, the lives of many poor families have changed as women are now able to sell their products directly to the customers. The special thing is that 22 Self-Help Groups are associated with this initiative.

- Apart from GI products like Thanjaur Doll and Bronze Lamp, these women Self Help Groups also craft toys, mats, and artificial jewellery. Due to such stores, the sales of GI products as well as handicraft products have seen a significant rise. Through this campaign, not only have the artisans got a fillip, but the women are also getting empowered by a rise in their income.
- I urge the listeners of 'Mann Ki Baat'... find out which Women Self Help Groups are working in your area. You should also collect information about their products and use these products as much as possible. By doing this, you will not only help in increasing the income of the Self Help Groups, but will also give impetus to the 'Self-reliant India Campaign'.
- Our country is a rich treasure house of many languages, scripts and dialects. Varied attire, cuisine and culture in different regions are our hallmark. As a nation, this diversity strengthens us and keeps us united. I wish to share with all of you a very inspiring example of beti Kalpana. Kalpana has recently passed her class 10th examination in Karnataka, but, the very special thing about her success is that, Kalpana did not know Kannada language till some time ago. She not only learned Kannada language in three months, but also scored 92 percent marks in the language paper. Kalpana is originally from Joshimath in Uttarakhand. She had been suffering from

TB earlier and when she was in the class three she lost her eyesight too, but, as they say, 'where there is a will, there is a way'. Kalpana later came in with Professor contact Taramurthy, a resident of Mysuru, who not only encouraged her but also helped her in every way. Today, through her hard work, she has set an example for all of us. I congratulate Kalpana for her fortitude.

I would urge all of you to celebrate 'Yoga Day' with great enthusiasm while taking precautions related to corona. The COVID pandemic has made all of us realize the overarching importance of health in our lives and Yoga being a great medium in ensuring the same. People are experiencing how much physical, spiritual and intellectual well being is receiving a boost through Yoga. From the world's top business persons to film and sports personalities, from students to common people, everyone is making yoga an integral part of one's life.
- I have come to know about innovative some very examples being held on 'Yoga Day' in the country and abroad. One of these is Guardian Ring - it will be a very unique programme. In this, the Movement of the Sun will be celebrated, that is, as the sun travels, we will welcome it through Yoga from different parts of the earth. Indian missions in different countries will organize Yoga programs at sunrise according to the local time there. The program will successively commence, following one country after another. The journey from east to west will go on continuously...and on these lines, it will proceed accordingly. Streaming of these programs will also be linked one after the other, that is, it will be a kind of relay Yoga streaming event. Do watch it.
- Keeping in mind the 'Amrit Mahotsav' in our country, 'International Yoga Day' will also be organized at 75 major places in the country. You will be very happy to know that he has directed the Mahabharat Project. This project was started in Cambodia and it is continuing for the last 9 years. Hiroshi Koikeji performs every task in a very different way. Every year, he travels to one country in Asia and produces parts of the Mahabharata with local artists and musicians there. Through this project, he has done productions and given stage performances in nine countries including India, Cambodia and Indonesia.
- Hiroshi Koikeji brings together artists who have had a diverse background in Classical and Traditional Asian Performing Performers Art. from Indonesia, Thailand, Malaysia and Japan make it more attractive through Java dance, Balinese dance, Thai dance. The special thing is that in this each performer speaks in his own mother tongue and the choreography very beautifully displays this diversity makes this production more lively.





Total digital transactions which were 1,004 crore in FY 2016-17 have seen exponential growth post the launch of UPI. During FY 2017-18, 106% growth was witnessed taking the tally to 2,071 crore transactions.

In FY 2018-19, UPI accounted for 17% of the total 31 billion digital transactions in the country. The next fiscal year saw UPI's share rising to more than 27% as it processed 12.5 billion transactions of the total 46 billion

In FY 2020-21, UPI accounted for 40% of the total 55 billion digital transactions. To put these numbers in context, the value of transactions on BHIM UPI amounted to 15% of India's GDP in FY 2019-20.

Question: What changes have you seen/are seeing around you that you think will go a long way to ease the pressure on traditional sources of energy, some of which are under threat of depletion? Also let us know your suggestions that you wish to see in the sphere of renewable energy.

#### BHOPAL

There are lots of positive takeaways from the rapidly changing energy landscape of our country. Thermal power plants and cogeneration units could be afforded only by financially sound organizations. But with the advent of rooftop solar panels, I saw that even MSMEs are installing solar panels to meet their energy demands. They also supply excess power to the government for which they are paid. With the advent of several solar panel installation companies, many households have also become "Atmanirbhar" in terms of fulfilling their energy needs. If the use of this renewable source is increased, we can definitely ease the pressure on traditional sources of energy in all forms of energy consumption.

Albania, Iceland and Paraguay are 100% powered by renewable energy. We need to focus on the following steps to achieve a similar feat:

- 1. Hydrogen to be developed as a fuel for transportation to reduce crude oil consumption.
- 2. Research and development required on improving efficiency of solar panels. They are currently less efficient and cheaper to install whereas thermal power plants are highly efficient but costly to install and operate.
- 3. Coal being on the path of extinction, there is an urgent need to develop alternate fuels (biomass being a potential alternative) for thermal power plants.
- 4. If the gobar gas system is efficiently designed and utilized then it can be a potential alternative for LPG cylinders. As a testimony, Gobar-Dhan plant in Indore fuels 400 CNG buses.
- 5. Installation of offshore wind projects, hydro power projects, geothermal energy need to be done.

#### NATIONAL

#### ■ President Confers Gallantry Awards during Defence Investiture Ceremony (Phase-2)

President Shri Ram Nath Kovind, who is the Supreme Commander of the Armed Forces, conferred one Kirti Chakra (Posthumous) and 14 Shaurya Chakras, including eight posthumous, to the personnel of the Armed Forces, Central Armed Police Forces and State/Union Territory Police during Defence Investiture Ceremony (Phase-2) at Rashtrapati Bhawan on 31st May. The Gallantry awards were given to the personnel for displaying conspicuous gallantry, indomitable courage and extreme devotion to duty. The President also conferred 13 Param Vishisht Seva Medals and 29 Ati Vishisht Seva Medals for distinguished service of exceptional order. #### ■ PM Modi-led Government Completes 8 Years

Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led NDA Government completed eight years on 31st May 2022 on the occasion of which a massive public outreach campaign was organized across the country. BJP's national general secretary Arun Singh said, the public outreach was being held on the theme of 'Service, Good Governance and Welfare of the Poor' as these have been the priority of the Prime Minister Modi-led Government. #### Country Achieves 50% Milestone of Har Ghar Jal Mission

The country has achieved the milestone of 50 per cent of rural households having access to tap water connections, according to the Ministry of Jal Shakti. Goa, Telangana, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu, Puducherry and Haryana have already achieved 100 per cent household connections. Punjab, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh and Bihar have coverage of more than 90 per cent and are progressing



fast towards attaining the status of "Har Ghar Jal." According to the Ministry, at the time of the launch of Jal Jeevan Mission in 2019, only 3.23 crore households (17 per cent of the rural population) had access to drinking water through taps.

#### ■ North India Gets its First Biotech Park in Kathua

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology Dr. Jitendra Singh inaugurated North India's first Biotech Park at Ghatti, Kathua district, J&K on 28th May. The Biotech Park would act as hub for incubation of new ideas and will act as a robust platform to support the agri-entrepreneurs, startups, progressive farmers, scientists, scholars and students not only from Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh but also from nearby states of Punjab, Haryana and Himachal Pradesh.

#### ■ 8th International Yoga Day theme - 'Yoga for Humanity'

The 8th edition of International Day of Yoga will be celebrated with theme "Yoga for Humanity". Ministry of Ayush said it has chosen this theme after much deliberation and consultation and that the theme appropriately portrays, how during the peak of COVID-19 pandemic, Yoga served the humanity in alleviating the sufferings and in the emerging post-COVID geo-political scenario too, it will bring people together through compassion, kindness, foster a sense of unity and build resilience among people world over.

#### ■ Har Ghar Dastak 2.0 COVID Vaccination Campaign Gets Underway

With the objective to accelerate the pace of COVID vaccination and achieve optimal coverage among all eligible beneficiaries, the government launched a two-month long Har Ghar Dastak campaign 2.0 on 1st June. The campaign will continue till the 31st of July this year, across all States and Union Territories. During this period, vaccination of all beneficiaries due for the second dose and eligible for precaution dose would be emphasized through door-to-door campaigning. Vaccination coverage of children aged 12 to 18 years will also be undertaken through a school-based campaign.

#### ■ Department of Legal Affairs Introduces Law Internship

The Department of Legal Affairs has introduced opportunity for internship for law students, under its offices in Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru, Kolkata and Chennai. #### INTERNATIONAL

#### ■ China Says It's Ready to Take Measures to Advance Bilateral Trade with India

China has said it is ready to take measures to advance normal trade with India amid reports that US has overtaken China to become India's biggest trade partner. Chinese foreign ministry spokesperson Zhao Lijian at a media briefing in Beijing insisted that China remains India's largest trading partner in the calendar year 2021 with bilateral trade volume of over USD 125 billion according to Chinese statistical measures. Zhao said the disparity in trade figures published by China and India is a result of different statistical measurement scales. China follows the financial year from January to December, while India calculates the same from April to March every year. According to the data of India's Ministry of Commerce, in FY 2021-22, the bilateral trade between the US and India stood at USD 119.42 billion as compared with the bilateral trade with China that aggregated at USD 115.42 billion. India's trade deficit with China rose to USD 72.91 billion in 2021-22 from USD 44 billion in the previous fiscal year as per Indian figures whereas the US is one of the few countries with which India had a trade surplus amounting to USD 32.8 billion last year.

# Portal Launched to Facilitate B2B Digital Trade between Indian Exporters and Foreign Buyers

The Federation of Indian Export Organizations (FIEO) has launched the Indian Business Portal - an international trade hub for Indian exporters and foreign buyers. The portal was inaugurated by Union Minister for Industry and Commerce Smt. Anupriya Patel on 27th May. The Union Minister observed that



during the pandemic online platforms such as e-commerce have shown immense potential in supporting millions of businesses to sustain themselves and that this initiative has come at very appropriate time as currently Indian exports are witnessing robust growth. The portal is a B2B (Business to Business) digital market-place to empower SME exporters to identify new markets for their products and grow their sales with new buyers. The objective of the portal is to enable online presence of every exporter, make exportable products and services discoverable online by buyers across the globe, and to maximise the leverage of exporter's existing infrastructure, production capacities and supply chains.

#### SPORTS

#### ■ In a First, All 36 State and UTs Participating in Khelo India Youth Games

The fourth edition of Khelo India Youth Games is being held from 4th June to 13th June 2022. Five new games namely Gatka, Thang-Ta, Kalaripayattu, Yogasana and Malkhamb have been introduced in this edition of the Games. Nearly 4,700 athletes, including 2,262 girls are participating in different disciplines vying for over



1850 medals. For the first time, all the 36 states and Union Territories are taking part in this edition of the Khelo India Youth Games, with hosts Haryana fielding the largest contingent of 398 athletes. Defending champions Maharashtra are fielding the second-largest contingent with 357 athletes while Delhi is fielding 339. Andaman & Nicobar has the smallest squad of six.
