3. Case Study: Deadly Pool-cars

9. Amazon rainforests, considered the lungs of the world, are approaching critical tipping point causing 'environmental degradation'. Study finds tree felling, modified land use by human activities is damaging, weakening and under mining ability of the forest to store its carbon supporting nature. Up to 38% (2.5 million sq. km) land is already lost by human activity and drought (Journal of Science, University of Campinas, Brazil and Lancaster University, UK, Jan 2023). The identified four main drivers of damage are: forest fires, habitat fragmentation along edges where deforested areas meet forest, logging and extreme drought.  
The report found that degradation emits amounts of carbon pollution equivalent to or even greater than those from deforestation. An appeal is for global action to combat climate change to help reduce the impact of extreme droughts.
